Community Partners for Child Safety is a voluntary, no cost to the family, state wide service to help parents and children. The main goal of Community Partners for Child Safety is to keep children safe and to provide support for the families. Parenting can be a struggle and at times assistance is needed. Community Partners for Child Safety can be that assistance through difficult times.

Who is eligible?

The family cannot have an open case with the Department of Child Services. The children in the home cannot have an open case with Juvenile Probation.

Families may receive assistance through:

- Home Based Services
- Timely, Effective and Appropriate Prevention Support Services
- Development of Family Case Plans
- Referrals to Resources and Supports Within the Community
- Support and Advocacy Services
